

EILEEN WALLACE FELLOWSHIP IN CHILDREN'S LITERATURE

The Eileen Wallace Children's Literature Collection at The University of New Brunswick provides funding for the purpose of research and scholarship in the field of children's literature. The award is valued up to \$5,000 Canadian per annum. To be eligible for this award, applicants must show evidence of scholarly knowledge in the field of children's literature, use UNB's Children's Literature Collection in the course of their research, and acknowledge both the fellowship and the collection in any subsequent publication that results from that research. This award is not intended to support research toward the completion of a degree program.

Applications should be made to the Dean of Libraries, University of New Brunswick, by **March 1st** of each year.
