

Ebooks: downloading ebrary ebooks using Adobe Digital Editions

You can read any ebook collection subscribed to by UNB Libraries **online** without the need to download the ebooks.

However, if you would like to download an ebrary ebook onto a personal device for **offline** reading, you will need to set up a free account with ebrary. For authentication purposes, remember to use your UNB or STU email when you set up your account. I'm going to log in to with an existing user name and password.

Next, find the ebook you would like to download. I am going to search for the history of book publishing. Go inside the record of the ebook. Next, select the "Full Download" button. Keep in mind that your book will expire in 14 days and you will need to download it again. Choose the type of device you would like to download the ebook to. I am going to select the Laptop/Desktop option.

Install Adobe Digital Editions through the provided link. This is a software that allows you to view and manage ebooks and other digital publications. For Windows, go to "Download Digital Editions for Windows." Save the installation file on your computer. Open the installer file and run it. Accept the terms of the licence agreement. Hit "next," "next" again, and "install."

Go back to your ebrary page and select "Done with this step" and then select "Download your book" to complete your download. You can open your book with Adobe Digital Editions.

When setting up Adobe Digital Editions, you will be asked to create a free Adobe ID. I will log in with my current account. Hit "authorize," "next," and "authorize" again. Hit "ok" when the computer has been authorized. You are now ready to read your ebook.
