

Ebooks: downloading EBSCO ebooks using Adobe Digital Editions

You can read any ebook collection subscribed to by UNB Libraries online without the need to download the ebooks. For offline reading, however, you will need to download an ebook onto your device. First, you will need to set up a free account with EBSCO. For authentication purposes, remember to use your UNB or STU email when you set up your account.

Next, find the ebook you would like to download. I'm going to search for the history of capitalism. Within the EBSCO results list you can click "Download (Offline)" or, if you are in our library catalogue (UNB WorldCat), go inside the record of the ebook and click "Download This eBook (Offline)."

Keep in mind that your EBSCO ebook will expire in 7 days and you will need to download it again. Before we select "Checkout & Download," under "Viewing Requirements," we see that Adobe Digital Editions 1.7.1. or higher is required for desktop viewing. This is a software that allows you to view and manage licensed ebooks.

For mobile devices, you can use the EBSCO ebook mobile app available for both Apple and Android. The updated mobile app does not require Adobe Digital Editions to function.

Before you checkout and download the ebook onto your desktop or laptop, install Adobe Digital Editions through the provided link. Once on the Adobe Digital Editions home page, click the "Download" option. Adobe Digital Editions has both Windows and Mac compatible versions to download. Choose an installer file appropriate for your operating system, save the file, and run it from wherever it was saved. Accept the terms of the license agreement and follow the other prompts of the system.

Once this is accomplished, go back to the tab with the gray message box (or find your ebook record and select the "Download This eBook (Offline)" option again to get to this window). Now we can select "Checkout & Download," which gives you the option to save or open the file. Since Adobe Digital Editions will now come up as an available software option, open the file. As a first-time user, you will have to create a free Adobe id and password in order to authorize your device. I'm going to enter my Adobe id and password, click "Authorize" and "OK."
